SAFETY RULES

The rules for younger children:

1. I KNOW my name, address, telephone number, and my parents' names.
2. I always CHECK FIRST with my parents or the person in charge. I tell them before I go anywhere or get into a car, even with someone I know.

3. I always CHECK FIRST with my parents or a trusted adult before I accept anything from anyone, even from someone I know.
4. I always TAKE FRIEND with me when I go to places or play outside.
5. I SAY NO if someone tries to touch me or treat me in a way that makes me feel scared, uncomfortable, or confused.
6. it's OK to SAY NO and I KNOW that there will always be someone who can help me.
7. I KNOW that I can TELL my parents or a trusted adult if I feel scared, uncomfortable, or confused.
8. I am STRONG, SMART, and have the right to be SAFE.

Rules for older children

1. DON'T GO OUT ALONE. There is safety in number. This rule isn't just for little kids, it applies to teens, too.
2. ALWAYS TELL AN ADULT WHERE YOU'RE GOING. Letting someone know where you'll be at all times is smart. If you're faced with a risky situation or get into trouble, your family and friends will know where to find you.
3. SAY NO IF YOU FEEL THREATENED. If someone –anyone –touches you in a way that makes you feel uncomfortable, you have the right to say no. When there is pressure about doing something that you know is wrong, be strong and stand your ground.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Pupils are expected to maintain a high standard of behavior and manner of speech.
2. In order to ensure proficiency in English, students are advised to speak in English during school hours.
3. Students should be well-behaved, respectful to their elders, honest and truthful. Pupils are answerable to the school authorities for their conduct in and outside the school.
4. Students are expected to be attentive in class and complete and hand in all assignments on time.
5. Personal hygiene and neatness is of vital importance. Students are expected to be well groomed and tidy.
6. Students are to wear the prescribed school uniform and modification to the uniform is not allowed. Uniform must be clean and ironed and shoes must be polished. Sport uniform must be worn on P.T. days.
7. Punctuality is essential at all times, students must reach school in time for the General Assembly during which silence should be maintained. Students who disregard this rule without valid reason will face appropriate action.
8. Students must keep their classrooms and campus neat, clean and presentable at all times. They should avoid littering the campus and should make use of bins provided.
9. A support team of responsible students (Students' Council) is selected each year to maintain the discipline of the school. Students must obey them at all times.
10. Students must not vandalize school property. Any damage to the school property must be made good by the concerned offender.

11. Under special circumstances, a student will be allowed to leave the school premises before the official closing time, only with a written permission from the Principal.
12. NO fine of any kind or collection or sale for any purpose whatsoever may be made without the previous sanction of the Principal.
13. Each child is responsible for his or her own belongings; Parents are advised not to allow their children to bring any valuables to school.
14. NO collective petition will be entertained but reasonable and private ones will be sympathetically attended to..
15. Private tuition in any subject from any member of the school staff without the permission of the Principal is forbidden.
16. The management reserves the right to dismiss students who make no progress in their studies or whose conduct is detrimental to the orderly life of the school. Irregular attendance, insubordination to teachers, habitual inattention to school work, obscenity in words or action, repeated damage to school property are sufficient reasons for dismissal of a student.
17. NO leave of absence is granted except for valid reasons and only on prior written applications by parents. Applications for medical leave should be accompanied by a medical certificate from a qualified doctor.
18. All students should present themselves on the opening day of the school after a vacation. Absentees, who do not give prior intimation of the delay, may have their names struck off the roll to enable the school to accommodate those on the waiting list.
19. Parents will not be permitted to meet or take their words during the school hours. No application shall be entertained in this regard.
20. A pupil, who for some unexplained reason has been absent for a month or more, is liable to have his/her name struck off without advance notice. If readmitted he or she will be considered as a case of fresh admission.
21. A minimum of 75% of total attendance during an Academic Session would necessary to appear for the Annual Examination. Shortage up to 10 % may be considered for condonation in case of genuine illness (if supported by a Medical certificate).
22. Members of staff are willing to meet, only by appointment, with parents to discuss any concerns or questions. All appointment should be made via the school diary.
23. The school must be immediately notified in writing of any change of address, telephone number and emergency contact details.
24. Students must adhere to school directives on the use of school facilities.

EVALUATION SYSTEM AND SCHEDULE

1. The School follows the Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation system (CCE) that includes assessment in scholastic and co-scholastic aspects of the pupil's growth
2. CCE helps in bringing awareness of the progress in the scholastic and co-scholastic achievements of the pupil, to the pupil himself/herself, to the teachers and to the parents, at regular intervals
3. The academic year is divided into two terms both having Formative and Summative Assessments
4. Report cards will be issued at the end of each term.
